Parents or careers all have a login to **Unifrog** the platform that includes an extensive library of careers and further education providers, labour market information. This can help parents or carers support students considering careers and pathways for the future. Careers notices are provided to students on the **Satchel One** app, which parents can also access and the notices provided.

- **What has my child been learning about careers this term?**

We've had a good start at Marshland with careers education in this first term. You'll find a summary below highlighting what each year group has been working on.

Year	Activity
Year 7	Introduced to Unifrog and quizzes to support finding out which careers match their hobbies, interests and personality. Homework on exploring careers using Unifrog.
	In Character and Culture lessons, students have been learning about what employability skills are and how they might be important in their future careers, with a focus on leadership skills.
	Assembly presented by an alumni student based on their pathway into a career.
Year 8	Completed the personality quiz on Unifrog to find out about different careers that might be of interest to them. Homework set on Unifrog to explore careers.
	In Character and Culture lessons, students have been working on developing oracy skills and relating these to interviews and presentations.
	Assembly presented by an alumni student based on their pathway into a career.
Year 9	Opportunity to update their reflections and quizzes on Unifrog. Homework to explore careers using Unifrog.
	In Character & Culture lessons, students have been learning about option subjects and the careers they might support them in pursuing. This is to help with their GCSE option choices in early 2024.
	Assembly from Springwood on A-Levels and what it is like to be a sixth form student; College of West Anglia (CWA) on T-levels & Apprenticeships, what they are and how they work; UEA Outreach (options); alumni student based on their pathway into a career.

	Super Learning Day November 2023 – New option subject taster sessions all day, off usual timetable
Year 10	Work experience has been launched with students considering possible placements for July 2024.
	Assembly presented by an alumni student based on their pathway into a career.
Year 11	Tutor lessons exploring Post-16 including Unifrog research. Students started their applications for Post-16 courses.
	Students applying for apprenticeships have had 1:1 support from Norfolk Pathways who also supported Y11 Parents Evening.
	Assemblies by Springwood High School (Sixth Form); College of West Anglia (T-Levels, Apprenticeships, A-Levels and alternative courses); Norfolk Pathways (Apprenticeships)
	Students continue to have a 1:1 appointment for specialist career guidance.
