

## Annual Activity Survey for Marshland High School

Welcome to Children's Services' annual Activity Survey, 2023. It provides information about the first destinations of young people reaching the statutory school leaving age in the summer of 2023. The cohort has increased this year by 5%. With over 9,000 young people to follow it has taken the dedication of a number of key people to make the survey possible. I would like to thank staff at schools, colleges and sixth forms along with Norfolk County Council's, Guidance Advisers, Young Person's Advisers, Keeping in Touch Team, and staff from the Participation, Transition & Strategy Team.

It is worth noting that all young people are expected to continue in education or training (in learning) until at least 18 years of age. Therefore the 'in-learning' figures are a particularly important focus of this report - which as you will see have slightly dipped again this year, a cumulative 2% in the past 2 academic years. This indicates an ongoing trend of young people going into jobs without training.

On a more positive note: the number of young people in an apprenticeship has increased again this year, an overall increase of 0.8% since 2021. NEETs are down by 0.5% compared to last year, despite the overall increased cohort size.

#### Norfolk Year 11 Count

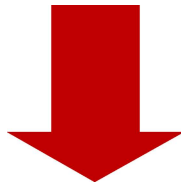


The total number of Year 11 students in Norfolk's schools for the academic year

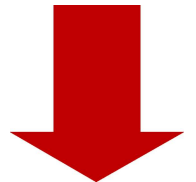
#### Full Time Education

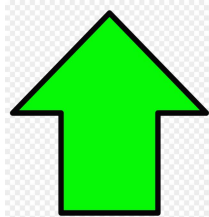
#### In Learning Percentage

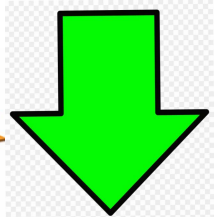

The percentage of young people who are **NEET**

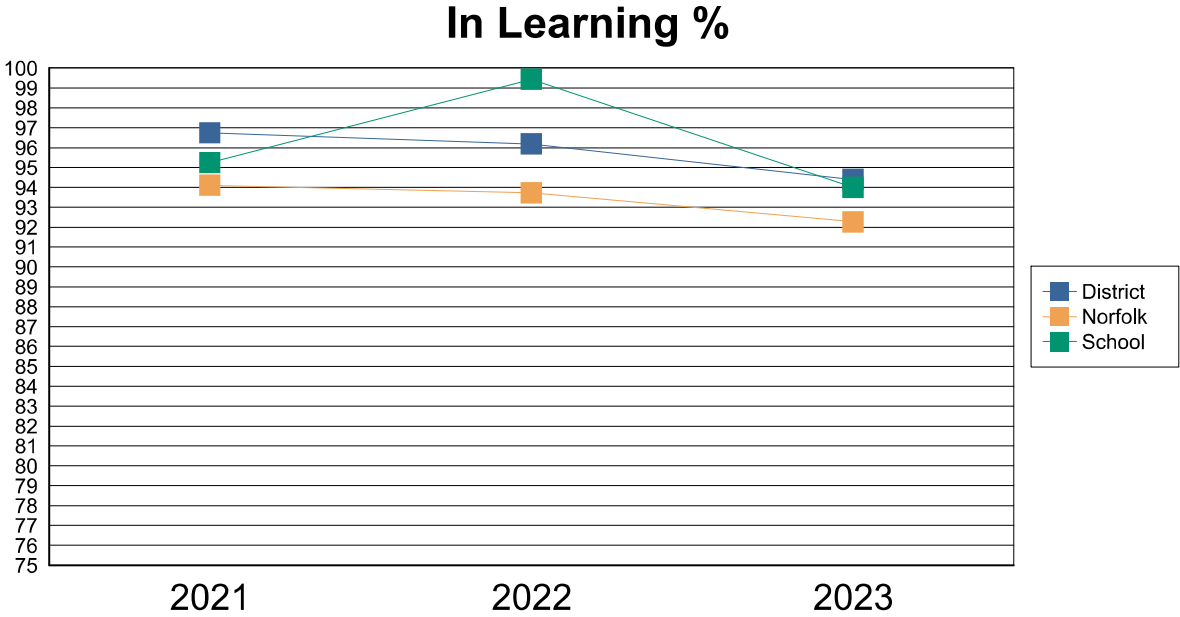
