Year 11 Update

Further to my letter before half term, two key updates.

- Prom will be going ahead at Knights Hill Hotel on 28th June. Last chance to buy tickets is tomorrow Friday 7th June. Full details remain as below.
- All students attending ALL exams and ALL revision sessions during the school day, must attend in their full uniform even after they leave on 11th June 2024.

1. Final day of lessons – Tuesday 11th June 2024

On Tuesday 11th June, all students sit GCSE Chemistry exam in the morning, with a number of sitting History exam in the afternoon. This will be the last full day of lessons for all students. Rooms will be available for any student who would like to remain in school for independent revision for the programme outlined below, if you do not wish to grant your child study leave from the 11th June.

Attendance to school up until 11th June is of paramount importance. Teachers have planned bespoke intervention for students to best prepare them for their exams in each remaining lesson. It is vital that your child is in school to receive this support. If your child fails to attend school at this time, their leaving privileges including leavers' assembly and Prom will be lost.

After 11th June, Geography, Physics, Polish, Additional Maths, Food and Nutrition revision and preparation sessions in the lead up to the exam will be taking place at the following times that students involved must attend. **Full uniform must be worn for all exams and revision sessions**.
