Dear Parents & Carers

Year 11 GCSE examination preparation and upcoming events.

I wanted to take the opportunity to update you on upcoming events in preparing your child for their GCSE examinations and Year 11 events for their remaining few months at Marshland.

With the latest set of PPEs exams now over, I wanted to say how impressed I have been with our students' behaviour and attitude in completing the theory and practical exams. I hope that the results reflect the effort that your child has applied to their revision.

I would remind you that if your child has an illness during the final exams in the summer, then a doctor's note is required to be sent to school for the exam board to make their final decision on any special consideration that may apply. Special considerations if only given in serious or exceptional circumstances and often has a very limited positive impact on a child's GCSE outcome. If your child fails to attend an exam with no valid reason, then the school may decide to charge you the entry fee.

The PPE papers are now being marked with plans to share the results and your child's final report with you the week commencing 13th March, ready for your child's last Parents Evening on **Thursday 16th March**. Parents Evening meetings will be held virtually between 4pm and 7pm, due to the ongoing building work at school. We will also remind your how to access your appointments through the same link.

Staff are working hard to ensure that your child is best prepared for the final exams and we have an extensive intervention programme taking place throughout the week (please see below). If your child has been invited to a session then they must attend to ensure that they achieve their target grade in the summer. If your child has not had an invitation then they should speak to their teachers about revision that they can be doing outside of lesson and utilising the GCSEPod website that the school has purchased to support their learning. Completing past exam board papers and checking their work themselves is highly recommended too. During the Easter and May half term breaks there will be additional revision sessions and details will be shared closer to the time. I would strongly recommend that your child attends as many of these as possible

I also must stress the importance of school attendance at this time. Every single lesson and intervention session really count, and I am sure that I can rely on you getting your child into school, even if they are a little under the weather.

During the examination period, we will be holding final revision sessions after school prior to each exam. This will be an opportunity to revise any last bits of information and to get your child fully prepared for their exam the following day with tips on how to answer questions as effectively as possible. Again, I will share further information nearer the time.

Between now and the final exams there will be a number of final practical/speaking exams in Creative Design, Art, Photography, Physical Education, French, German and English. These exams all contribute towards your child's final grade and must be completed on the set dates. Failure to attend these practical/speaking exams will significantly impact your child's chance of
