We have been alerted that there is currently an issue with the use of 'Spice' by young people in the local area and although we have not had any direct concerns regarding our students we, as a school, need to safeguard our students against such dangers.

Pupils have been reminded of the dangers of drugs through tutor lessons, which supports the work already done in Skills for Life lessons. The school works closely with The Matthew Project (a drugs charity in Norfolk and Suffolk) to deliver drugs education and to support students in school and they have offered to come into school and talk to parents about any concerns they have.

The session will run as a drop-in session with a member of The Matthew Project staff and will be held on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> June from 5pm until 6pm. This will be held in the Library.
